

Blessed Trinity Catholic Church STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

RESPECT

- Listen to and follow directions of the catechist.
- Teasing and name calling of fellow classmates is not tolerated.
- Touching school materials or other student's belongings is not permitted.
- Help keep the room straightened and return supplies as requested.

SELF-CONTROL

- Stay seated unless otherwise directed by the catechist.
- Do not leave the room without a catechist's permission.
- Students may not go on the stage, play on the steps, or run inside the Parish Center

PREPAREDNESS

- Bring your homework (if assigned).
- Class time is limited; prepare for class by using the bathroom prior to sessions.
- Have a snack or meal before class to get the most out of class time.
- Parents assist their children with any lessons not completed in class.
- No FOOD inside classrooms

DISCIPLINARY ACTION

- **FIRST OFFENSE:** Student will be warned by catechist and reminded of the Student Code of Conduct. Catechist may involve the Director of Faith Formation and parents as appropriate.
- **SECOND OFFENSE:** Parents will be notified of the student's misconduct by the catechist or the Director Faith Formation. Misconduct may be noted in the child's records.
- **THIRD OFFENSE:** The student will be escorted by a catechist to the Hall of the Parish Center to sit for the remainder of the session with the Director of Faith Formation or Designee. The Director of Faith Formation will speak with a parent(s). The remainder of the sessions may need to be taught at home by a parent(s).
